WATER & SEWER

PSM/Fire Chief Jeff King reported on some neighborhood issues and checking on cameras to determine standing water issue at 10th and Calhoun Street. PSM/Chief King stated citation was issued for mowing.

STREETS & ALLEY

Alderman Waldorf made a motion to approve a quote from Advanced Asphalt for water main break repair work in the amount of \$16,680.00. Alderman Lukosus seconded the motion. Clerk Bartley called the roll with Alderman Waldorf, Lukosus, Ballard and Edgcomb voting aye; motion carried.

ELECTRIC

Committee discussed proposal from Hydro Consulting & Maintenance Services for repairs for to hydro unit 2 in the amount of \$190,562.00.

Committee discussed proposal from J.F. Brennan Company in the amount of \$17,620.00 for hydro underwater dive inspection and assist.

LANDFILL

PSM/Fire Chief Jeff King reported the work filling holes is ongoing

AIRPORT

Eric Carls, Director of Engineering and Zoning reported on IL Division of Aeronautics grant for the T-Hangar pavement rehabilitation. Mr. Carls stated of the \$600,000+ approximately \$32,200 will be the city's responsibility.

CEMETERY

Mayor Kolowski reported on fence project at the cemetery. Mayor Kolowski stated MAP Quality will install 786 linear feet of aluminum fencing for \$44,700. Mayor Kolowski stated IL Valley Excavating will remove remaining fence for \$5,000.

PARKS & RECREATION

Adam Thorson, Parks, Recreation and Special Events reported the city was not awarded the OSLAD grant for Washington Park All Seasons Project and is verifying a documentation issue.

Mayor Kolowski reported on the potential to have a tractor display at the airport next August 2023. Alderman Lukosus was opposed because it is a non-aviation event that would utilize city resources. Aldermen Payton, Waldorf and Sapienza concurred.

Alderman Edgcomb asked Eric Carls, Director of Engineering and Zoning to give an update on the berm work at Pohar Crossing and some overgrowth with weeds. Mr. Carls reported the landscaper has been tasked to cleanup and mow the city property behind the Parkside Drive homes. Mr. Carls noted the city spent a lot of money with intent to take care of it.
