I am pleased to present the 2012 calendar year report for the Peru Police Department.

You will see from the review of the report that 2012 was yet another busy year for everyone at the police department. I am very proud of the accomplishments of our staff and the dedication and support they have shown towards department initiatives. I believe we continue to make significant progress towards organizational change that will prepare the department to meet the needs of the City of Peru for years to come. This annual report is a compilation of the activity, training and accomplishments of the Peru Police Department during 2012. There are many examples of fine work performed by our staff detailing their commitment to the goals of the department in the area of public safety, community partnership, customer service, and professionalism.

During 2012, just some of the major projects completed were:

- 1) Narrow banding of all radio frequencies serving the City of Peru.
- 2) Upgrading the city siren infrastructure due to FCC narrow banding mandates.
- 3) Acquisition of new public safety radios for all emergency services in City of Peru and reallocation of all existing radios to public works and city electric.
- 4) Installation of new records management server.
- 5) Acquisition of new in car video system replacing aged equipment. Today the Peru Police Department enjoys the most state of the art in car video system in North Central Illinois.
- 6) Installation of new city wide paging system for all Peru emergency services.
- 7) New signage for police facility.
- 8) Upgrades of a variety of equipment throughout the department.
- 9) With the unbelievable support of Public Works and City Electric we now have the finest police firing and K-9 training facility in North Central Illinois.
- 10) Began acquisition of new AR-15 patrol rifles for patrol personnel.
- 11) Start up of North Central Illinois' first Administrative Adjudication System.

I am very pleased with these continuing improvements and changes that have already taken place, the ones in progress, and the anticipated ones to come. The strength of any organization is in it's personnel and I'm very proud of the efforts that our members have made during the past year. It is an honor to lead the men and women who make up the Peru Police Department. I am also very appreciative of the continuing support from the Mayor, City Council, and other City Officials, for without your support we would not move forward! We look forward to a promising 2013 for our police department.
